1. The minutes of the last meeting were accepted as a true record with the exception of the description of the future use of the Joff field. The lay-out of the Joff field is still under consideration.
2. Welcome to Eleanor Moulton from North Peacehaven Community Project who has replaced Sam Rowe on a part-time basis.
3. No further reports were available from the Working Groups as they had not met since the last meeting.
4. John Livings reported that the Sports and Leisure Group were due to meet with Directors of YMCA and ESCC Youth Services on Monday 30th September at The Joff to discuss potential future partnerships. Members made several suggestions as to the facilities needed in the Towns.
5. John Livings reported on the football match between a Peacehaven/Parker Pen Team and "Spurs" X1. Over £400 was raised and will be used towards a bid to improve the sports facilities in the Towns. Over 150 supporters attended, including Councillors Sue Griffiths, John Livings, Marjory Stanton and Len Stanton. The Town Leisure Manager and member of his partnership, Steve Keogh, played for Peacehaven. Most of the Peacehaven Town Council staff were supporters and helpers.
6. Liz Lee reported that progress was being made towards more Adult Education facilities in the Towns, especially at the Telscombe Civic Centre.
