

**Peacehaven and Telscombe Regeneration Partnership
Sports and Leisure Working Group
Monday November 11th 2002**

Present: John Livings, David Neighbour, ESCC, John Shepherd, YMCA, Steve Keogh, Peacehaven Amenities Manager, Jo Kidd, Leisure Centre, Jan Murphy, Haven District Youth Service.

There was some discussion around the planning of YMCA activities in Peacehaven. John Shepherd to draw up an Action Proposal Plan for YMCA involvement in Peacehaven. A pilot project was proposed for Easter 2003 for a film and theatre workshop. They would use the Joff as a base and use the editing room for film production. Films produced could be included in the Peacehaven Cinema evening prior to the main film.

John Shepherd will contact the Youth Participation Worker, Sports Development Officer, PACT and other relevant agencies to ensure that there is no duplication of projects.

The Action Plan will be presented at the next meeting.

Jan Murphy will contact Philip Scott (ESCC Music Services) to see if we can obtain music tuition and help to reform the local Scouts and Guides marching band, which was sadly missed at this year's Remembrance Day Parade. Jan said she would speak to the Sports Development Officer, but most money had gone to Newhaven.

Steve Keogh and Jo Kidd are hoping to promote a five a side football competition during the Christmas holidays and a Peacehaven Fun Day in August. The East Sussex Association for the Blind are to hold a vintage car show in July and it is hoped that all local groups will be involved in events and stands at this two day event.

David Neighbour stated the Telscombe Town Council are to go ahead with a skate board park but hope to have support from the Regeneration Partnership for a Baseball Area.

Jo Kidd said that funding is needed to train staff to NVQ3 or equivalent to run under 8's at the Leisure Centre. It was questioned whether a Diploma for Play work qualification would be appropriate. John Livings will investigate NVQ funding through the EYDCP.

Steve Keogh stated that estimates for possible disabled play area equipment at the Cairo Ave /South Coast Road site have now been received by Town Council. The Regeneration Partnership would be keen to have this project as part of a funding bid through the LSP,
